Eligibility:	The regatta is open to boats in the following handicap classes: PHRF Non-Spinnaker
	Entrants must have a current valid rating on file with PHRF of the Chesapeake.
Skipper's Meeting:	The skipper's meeting for all days is at 11:00 a.m. on the deck behind the Afterdeck Café at Washington Sailing Marina.
Rendezvous:	The rendezvous time for all days is at 12:00 p.m. near channel marker "R6."
Start:	The start time for all days will be at approximately 12:15 p.m. The start will be between the pin "R6" and the no wake buoy directly west of "R6" where the Race Committee would normally anchor. The start sequence will be announced over the radio (channel 79A) and audible signals such as horns will be used.
Courses:	The course will be announced at the skipper's meeting and over the radio (channel 79A) shortly after the rendezvous time.
	It is the intention of the Race Committee to run one race on the Middle Course. The Race Committee will select an appropriate course given the prevailing weather conditions and communicate that course to the fleet over the radio (channel 79A) shortly after the rendezvous time.

Time Limit: 3 hours

- Rules:The regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing<br/>2017-2020 (RRS) including the prescriptions of US Sailing (RRS) except as any of these<br/>are altered by the Notice of Race, Event Sailing Instructions or any amendments thereto.<br/>The Low-Point Scoring System in RRS Appendix A will apply.
- Protests:Protests must be made in accordance with the US Sailing rules 2017-2020. Protests must<br/>be filed by emailing officers@discsailing.org<br/>by 6 p.m. of the day of the race.

Other:Three 1 ton cranes and two launch ramps are available for launch and recovery. Some<br/>limited wet slips may be available through Washington Sailing Marina, 1 Marina Drive,<br/>Alexandria, Virginia.
